The goal of these guidelines is to <u>raise the standard of training</u> <u>and education</u> on the highest possible level for all Technical Delegates (TDs).

- 1) Education and training as national TD
- Attend a 1st FIS regional TD seminar with necessary theoretical and practical knowledge
- 3) Gain experience in key positions at FIS level competitions during the subsequent two years training period – be evaluated by a TD
